Association Purpose; To engender greater fellowship and knowledge among the Midwest Shrine Centers and their members: and to secure greater recognition of the institution of Shriner's International throughout the territory of this association

The Chief Rabban of each Shrine Center is responsible to ensure all delegates have registered and housing rooms have been requested through the MSA Secretary/Treasurer by his shrine center using the registration and housing forms provided. Fees for registration and rooms are in **US FUNDS**.

REGISTRATION: Registration for the 2024 MSA Winter session is \$116.80/person (US Funds) which includes Breakfast, Lunch, and Banquet on Friday as well as Breakfast on Saturday and access for delegates into the sessions. Nobles who are not registered will not be provided with meals. All meals will be in the Radisson Hotel La Crosse.

HOUSING; The Radisson Hotel La Crosse is the host hotel and the MSA has blocked a total of 124 guestrooms for Thursday and Friday nights, - 65 King Singles \$136.85/night (20 can be converted into doubles with a cot) & 57 Queen Doubles at a cost of \$\$159.85/night (US Funds).

Overflow Hotel is the Home 2 by Hilton across the street from the convention center (3/4 Block from Radisson,

room rates are \$148.55 Single or double.

HOSPITALITY ROOMS; Zor Shriners have arranged for a room on the second floor as the MSA Temples hospitality room which they will partner/split the costs with Wawa Shriners, Kem Shriners, and Aad Shriners. If other Temples wish to have a hospitality room King Single guest rooms will be used at the rate of \$136.85/night plus a \$75.00 for removal of furniture.

All rooms will be reserved and assigned to Shrine Centers in order of registration being received. Checkout is 11:00 AM (extended checkout with fee may be available, check at front desk) luggage storage is available.

The deadline for registration and housing requests is January 17, 2024. Room Requests and Delegate Registrations are due to the Secretary Treasurer by 5:00 PM, Wednesday January 17, 2024. The Shrine Centers will be invoiced based upon registrations as of that date. Rooms requested after this date may not be available in this hotel or at the MSA Rate.

AIRPORT: La Crosse has a Regional Airport that is serviced by American Airlines out of Chicago

DRIVING; Vehicle and Bus Parking is Available in the Hotel Parking Lot.

PAST M.S.A. OFFICERS: All Past M.S.A. officers must register and make room reservations through their own Shrine Centers.

IMPERIAL OFFICERS: At this time, MSA has not been advised which Imperial officers will be attending.

LADIES: The MSA Winter business session is a stag event. There are no activities planned or arranged for the ladies or families during MSA Winter Business Sessions.

ROOMS: Room rates (US Funds) are indicated above and on the Housing registration form. The M.S.A. Sec/Treas. will attempt to honor all special room type requests based on receipt date of housing form provided by the Shrine Center.

General Information

Meals – Meals are provided for registered delegates only. Each registered delegate will be provided with a name tag which must be visible for access to meals. General delegates breakfast buffet will be held in the Radisson Ballroom beginning at 7:00 AM and closing at 8:15 both Friday and Saturday mornings.

The Potentates, Chief Rabbans, Assistant Rabbans, High Priests & Prophets, Oriental Guides and Treasurers/Recorders will have their individual counterpart's breakfast on Friday March 1, 2024, at 7:00 AM. (Rooms to be confirmed). This time can be used by those groups to discuss activities for the year or any matters they wish to present at the General Business session. Friday's Lunch and the Banquet will be held in the Radisson Hotle Ballroom.

The M.S.A. Executive Committee; will meet for breakfast at 7:00 AM on Saturday morning March 2, 2024, in the Wisconsin 1&2 Room. *Executive Committee Members are; M.S.A. elected officers, Past M.S.A. Officers, Imperial Officers and member Temple Potentates/designate.*

The Chairman of the Nominating Committee will be the Potentate of the El Riad Shriners, the temple scheduled to host the Midwest Shrine Association Session in 2028. He will nominate the complete slate of MSA officers for the ensuing year which includes the President, the 4 Vice Presidents and the Secretary Treasurer.
